3. Action Points

RG to look into date for Club Dinner - ongoing.

5. Freshers' Plays

EB outlines that we now have enough of a range to try and pick some, so committee can now focus on reading plays on the shortlist.

Harlequinade looks like the best option if a straight comedy is what is wanted. Committee agrees for it to be pencilled in for the Lateshow. IW to look into the rights.

EB thinks *Consensual* (Evan Placey) is the best for Mainshow slot. Possibility of issues with the need for intimacy training but that doesn't mean we shouldn't consider it. It also

features interesting possibilities for design. Plays also on the shortlist include *Second Person Narrative*, *Punk Rock*, *Tiger Country*.

IW to look into rights for the shortlist as that may affect choice.

NH outlines May 23rd and 24th as the dates that interviews for ADC Mainshows will occur. It is agreed that this is the deadline to agree the final shortlist and begin investigating.

Everyone to keep reading plays on the shortlist

It is agreed that SF will sit on show selection panel and PRJ will sit on panto selection panel.
